GOOD SAMARITANS!

In Luke 10, the story of the "Good" Samaritan was told in answer to the challenging question, "Who is my neighbor?" (Luke 10:29) In this tale we see a Samaritan who is willing to do what a righteous priest and Levite would not for a man who had been left for dead by those who had robbed him. The Samaritan treated the man's physical needs and then took him to a safe place and paid for his board and continued care. After sharing this story, Jesus said to his challenger, "You go and do likewise." (Luke 10:37)

In John 4, the second Samaritan we see is the woman at the well. She is clearly skeptical of a Jew who would interact with a Samaritan - and a woman at that! As their conversation progresses, she is more than willing to take Jesus' offer of free water - an offer she takes literally. Jesus is not put off by her desire for relief from physical thirst and hard labor, but He also doesn't shy away from addressing her real and more important spiritual need. continued pg. 2
